The plaintiff, Hayden and Campbell, state that they are partners and as such conduct a general business in the town of Mackville, Washington County, Kentucky.

They say that on the first day of January 1921 the defendant herein executed and delivered to them a certain writing whereby he promised and agreed to pay six months after date the sum of \$ 64.18. Plaintiff says that the defendant has failed and refused to pay as above setout and still fails and refuses to pay said note or writing as promised and agreed and that no part of said note is has been paid except that on January 4th 1924 this defendant paid the sum of \$ 28.15 and that on March the 1st 1924 he paid the sum of \$ 12.51 the said \$12.51 being the interest due to said date-to-wit: March 1st, 1924. Plaintiffs say that the balance is now due and owing and that although often requested payment has been refused.
