

# BAIL BOND.

THE COMMONWEALTH OF KENTUCKY, MERCER COUNTY COURT.

THEREFORE, we \_\_\_\_\_ Principal and \_\_\_\_\_ Surety, of Mercer County, Kentucky do hereby undertake that the above named H. J. Taylor shall appear in the Mercer County Court, on the 10<sup>th</sup> day of Jan., 1920, to answer to said charge, and shall at all times render himself amenable to the order and process of said Court in the prosecution of said charge, and if convicted shall render himself in execution thereof; or if he shall fail to perform either of these conditions, that we will pay to the Commonwealth of Kentucky the sum of 100<sup>00</sup> Dollars.
