BAIL BOND.

THE COMMONWEALTH OF KENTUCKY, MERCER COUNTY COURT.

The Defendant JM Board being in custody
of the Sheriff of Mercer County, charged with the offense
of Shooting & wounding and
being admitted to bail in the sum of five hundred Dollars:

THE THEREFORE, we JM Board Principal
and C E Rankin Surety, of Mercer County, Kentucky,
do hereby undertake that the above named JM Board
shall appear in the Mercer County Court, on the 30
day of Dec 1920, to answer said charge, and shall at all times
render himself amenable to the order and process of said Court in the
prosecution of said charge, and if convicted shall render himself in execu-
tion thereof; or if he shall fail to perform either of these conditions, that
we will pay to the Commonwealth of Kentucky the sum of five hundred
Dollars.
