

Wilham his promisory note by which he agreed to pay him 8 months thereafter the sum of \$125.00 with interest after maturity; that by the terms of said note, notice of presentment for payment and notice of protest was waived; that before the maturity of said note the defendant R. A. Wilham, by his written endorsement on the back thereof, negotiated said note to the Farmers Bank of Salvisa, Kentucky; that said note is long past due; that no part thereof has ever been paid; that a copy thereof is filed herewith as a part hereof; that the Farmers Bank of Salvisa, Kentucky is according to law in the hands of the plaintiff for liquidation.
