The defendant having been duly summoned and failing to answer and make
and defense herein, it is adjudged that the plaintiff A.B.Teater, recover of the
defendant Blue Louallin the sum of \$50.05 with 6% per annum interest thereon
from the 9th, day of January, 1922, till paid and his costs herein expended and
it is further adjudged that to secure said debt the plaintiff has a lien on
the undivided interest of defendant in and to a crop of Tobacco raised on the
Fitzgerald place in Mercer County, Kentucky, and that the attachment herein
together with the grounds therefor be and the same are hereby sustained and it
appearing that said crop of tobacco is in the Pool, it is ordered that S.W.
Sheriff Mercer County, Ky,
Kennedy, sell said tobacco according to the contract and terms of the Burley
Tobacco Growers Cooperative Association and the proceeds from said sale he
will distribute according to the further orders of this Court.
