The plaintiff, *H.B. Hanna*, states that in the years and *H.B. Hanna*, 1918, 1919, 1920, /1921 he sold to the defendant, Fred Starling goods and merchandise at his special instance and request of the value of several hundred dollars and that said account has been credited by the payment by the said defendant at various times and amounts until now the balance due on said account is \$107.65, the last payment on said account being made on the 11th day of September, 1921, of \$3.00.

He says that the said balance due is just, and that he ought to recover thereon said amount and that ~~said sum is~~ this is an action for money due upon a contract and that the defendant has no property in this State subject to execution or not enough thereof to satisfy plaintiff's demands and the demands of the defendants creditors and that the collection of said demand will be endangered by delay in obtaining a judgment and a return of no property found. The original account is filed herewith and made a part hereof. Wherefore plaintiff prays for a judgment against the ~~proper~~ defendant in the sum of \$107.65, for all costs of this action and for a general order of attachment against the property of the defendant. He prays for all relief to which he is or may appear to be entitled-
