Defts

Plaintiff, a Ky corporation, says the defendants by their
promisory note dated ~~July 9, 1915~~ ^{July 9, 1915} agreed and promised to pay it on ~~July 1, 1916~~ ^{Jany 1, 1916} \$109.20, which note is filed herewith; that said note is past
due and no part thereof has ever been paid; that said note was given
in payment for a Bohon closed top buggy, and by the terms of said note
plff retained title to and a lien on said buggy until it was paid for
and by reason thereof it now has a lien on the said buggy, and it asserts
its said lien.

Wherefore it prays judgment for \$109.20, with interest from Jany 1, 1916 until paid and costs and for the enforcement of its lien
on said buggy and all proper relief.
