

MERCER QUARTERLY COURT. *Dec term 1924*

The above styled case having duly come on for trial and the defendant H. D. Burnes, having been duly served with summons and attachment herein more than ten days before this term of Court it is ordered that this case be, and the same is hereby submitted for judgment; and the Court being sufficiently advised adjudges that the plaintiff, O. A. Kays, recover of the defendant H. D. Burnes, the sum of one hundred--eighty dollars and five cents ( 180.05 ) with interest thereon at six per cent per annum from February 28th 1923, until paid, and the costs of this action, for which execution may issue in due course; and the Court being further advised, adjudges that the order of attachment herein granted and levied on the one half interest in eight acres of tobacco and one third interest in eight acres of corn raised on the farm of Mrs. James Patterson- on the Curry Pike in Mercer County, Kentucky, be, and the same is hereby fully sustained, and the plaintiff is adjudged a valid and subsisting lien on said interest in said tobacco and corn by virtue of said attachment to secure the debt, interest and costs herein.

And it appearing that said tobacco has been pooled with the Burley Tobacco Growers' Cooperative Association the Sheriff of Mercer County, Kentucky, is hereby ordered and directed to superintend the stripping of said tobacco and to see that said tobacco is delivered to said Association here at Harrodsburg, Kentucky, and in the name of said H. D. Burnes; and the said Association is now ordered and directed to pay into this Court out of the first payment made on said tobacco of H. D. Burnes a sum sufficient to satisfy the debt, interest and costs herein. In the event there is not a sufficient sum of money coming to H. D. Burnes from the first payment on said tobacco to satisfy this debt then the Association is ordered and directed to pay into this Court whatever sum or sums of money may hereafter be due the said H. D. Burnes, or a sufficient amount thereof to take care of any balance that may be due after said first payment on this tobacco is applied to this debt.

It is further ordered that the Sheriff of Mercer County, Kentucky, notify said Burley Tobacco Growers Cooperative Association of this judgment.
