HARRODSBURG — Lonnie E. Gray, 65, of 401 Arrowhead Drive, died at 2 a.m. Friday at the Veterans Administration Medical Center in Lexington.

Born Sept. 15, 1921, in Garrard County, he was a son of Parlee Carmickal Gray of Harrodsburg and the late Floyd Gray. He was a retired contractor and a U.S. Army veteran of World War II and the Korean Conflict. He was a Prisoner of War for 42 months and participated in the Bataan Death March.

Survivors include a son, Tony Gray of Harrodsburg; two daughters, Nancy Murphy of Harrodsburg and Glenda Daugherty of Danville; a brother, Henry Gray of Florida; one sister, Myrtle Turner of Kentucky; five grandchildren; and two great-grandchildren.

The funeral will be held at 2 p.m. Sunday at Alexander and Royalty Funeral Home, Harrodsburg, by the Rev. Ernest Martin. Burial will be in Camp Nelson National Cemetery in Jessamine County.
