The plaintiffs Ransdell & Son state that they are a firm composed of M.L.Ransdell and Franklin Ransdell going a general merchandise business in Harrodsburg, Ky, and that the defendant Marcus Lyons is indebted to them in the sum of \$10,54 for goods wares and merchandise which they furnished to the defendant at his special instance and request and for which he promised and garred to pay; they say that said claim is just, due and unpaid and that they have demanded payment of same but that the defendant has filed and refused to pay same; they say that they believe they ought to recover said amount from the defendant with interest and costs; they say the defendant has no property in this State subject to execution or not enough thereof to satisfy plaintiffs claim and claims of defendant creditors.

Wherefore plaintiffs pray judgment against the defendant for the said sum of \$10,54 with interests and costs, for a general order of attachment against the property of the defendant; that the Mercer National Bank of Harrodsburg, Ky, be summoned as Garnishee herein and for whatever relief they may appear entitled to.
