

note. The defendant states that the said plaintiff had no interests whatever either in the \$310. note or in the restaurant as all matters were settled between them. The defendant states that he sold said restaurant for \$350.00 and that out of this sum he paid to the Farmers Bank at Salvisa the \$250. note and \$30. interest, and that he was forced to expend \$69.00 in getting the restaurant in shape for sale. He states that these sums were paid to other parties in running and carrying for same. He states that he consumed 10 days of his time, which was reasonable worth \$20.00. The plaintiff reserves a right to further plead orally in this case.
