The Commonwealth of Kentucky,

To the Sheriff, Constable, Jailer, Marshal, or Policeman in the State of Kentucky:

It appearing <sup>from the oath of Miss Katie Carpenter</sup> that there are reasonable grounds for believing that

has committed the offense of

neglecting or refusing to send his child

in the County of Mercer, the October day of 1919

You are therefore commanded to arrest said Mack Merriam  
and bring him before me to be dealt with according to law.
