

Warrant of Arrest

The Commonwealth of Kentucky,

To the Sheriff, Constable, Jailer, Marshal or Policeman in the State of Kentucky:

It appearing that there are reasonable grounds for believing that

Harry Martin,

has committed the offense of

unlawfully with intent to defraud, did utter a check on the Farmers National Bank of Danville, Kentucky, knowing at the time there was no funds to pay same.

You are therefore commanded to arrest said Harry Martin,

and bring him before me to be dealt with according to law.
