The Plaintiff First National Bank of Harrodsburg, states that it is a corporation duly organized under the laws of the United States as a national bank with its principal place of business at Harrodsburg Ky.

It states that on Feby 9th 1921, the defendant by his promissory note which he executed and delivered to the plaintiff agreed and promised eight months thereafter to pay to the plaintiff the sum of \$200. with interest thereon from date, no part of which has ever been paid. That by mutual mistake in drawing said note it recites that interest is payable after maturity but by said contract and agreement it was to bear interest from date. Said note is filed herewith

Wherefore it prays judgment against the defendant for the said sum of \$200. with interest thereon from Feby 9th 1921 and for its cost and for all proper relief.
