

Warrant of Arrest

The Commonwealth of Kentucky,

To the Sheriff, Constable, Jailer, Marshal or Policeman in the State of Kentucky:

It appearing that there are reasonable grounds for believing that

Arline Payne, or Jones

has committed the offense of aiding and abetting another, Thomas Hall, in the illegal transportation of Moonshine liquor, not for sacramental purposes in the County of Mercer, the 22nd day of August 1931.

You are therefore commanded to arrest said Arline Jone or Payne,

and bring her before me to be dealt with according to law.
