promise to pay to the order of M. L. Vaught, one hundred sixty-eight 24/100
Dollars negotiable and payable at the Mercer National Bank of Harrodsburg
Ky value received with interest at eight per cent per annum from date un-
till paid, and we the drawers and endorsers severally waive presentment for
payment, protest or notice of protest. M. L. Lake J. H. Yates"

He states that M. L. Vaught died intestate and that E. P.

Vaught is his duly qualified and acting Administrator; that said note is

long past due; that no part thereof has been paid.

Wherefore the plaintiff prays judgment against the defendants

for \$168.24 with 6% interest from Feb'y 18th 1909, until paid and costs.
