Plaintiff, George Ann Teater, alias Mrs. S. R. Teater,

says that the Defendant E. W. Royalty, by his promissory note, dated Jan. 1, 1922, which he executed and delivered to Plaintiff, promised and agreed to pay her 6 months after said date the sum of ONE HUNDRED AND TWELVE DOLLARS, with 6 per

cent interest thereon from date until paid, no part of which has been paid. Said note is filed herewith as part hereof marked EXHIBIT "A".

Wherefore she prays judgment against Dft. for the sum

\$112.00 and interest at the rate of 6 per cent per annum from Jan. 1, 1922, until paid and her cost herein expended.

Plaintiff further states that the nature of her debt is as set out her above that it is just; and she believes she ought to recover of Defendant the sum of \$112.00 and her cost herein expended. She says that her debt is due upon contract, and that the Defendant has no property in this state subject to execution, or not enough thereof to satisfy Plaintiff's demand, and the collection thereof will be endangered by delay in obtaining judgment and a return of no property found. Wherefore she prays for a general order of attachment against the Defendant and for all proper relief

Affiant, George Ann Teater is one and the same person as Mrs. S. R. Teater, and that she is Plaintiff in this action, and that the averments of the petition are true.
