Plaintiff, C.E. Raymond, says that he is the owner and entitled to the possession of a Herron Bone Blue Serge Suit of clothes, two piece, which the defendants detain and have detained without right for thirty days or longer, and which the said Barnes without right failed and refused to deliver to plaintiff though plaintiff at the check room of the L.E. Myers Company on or about the 11th., day of February 1925 made demand upon the defendant for said property and again on the 11th., day of March 1925 said demand upon defendant was made which was refused by the defendant Barnes.

Plaintiff says that he is ready and is able to identify said property and has made demand upon defendants for said property but that without right defendant is detaining and refusing to surrender said property to this plaintiff.

Plaintiff says that he is the rightful owner of said property and is entitled to the immediate possession of the same.

Wherefore, plaintiff, asks for judgment against defendants for possession of said property and for damages for the
