Rules For Mercer Co. Spelling

Bee Contest On March 21, 1936

Rules for the Mercer County Spelling Bee Contest, March 21, 1936.

1. Any pupil who has not passed beyond the eighth grade at the time of holding the contest will be eligible to enter.

2. The preliminary contest will be written.

3. Capital letters and hyphens will be disregarded.

4. The contestants will receive a number when they are placed for the contest, and only the number must appear on the paper to be graded. The name of the contestant and the school must be omitted.

5. Two hundred words will be selected by some person out of the county. These words will be sealed in an envelope and forwarded to the office of the superintendent. This envelope will be opened in the presence of the contestants, the judges, and the pronouncer. The first hundred words will be taken from The Child's Centered Speller by Dr. Adams; the remainder will be taken from the Jones Speller and Arnold's Dictionary of Words.

6. Fifty words will be pronounced and the papers graded. If it is found that more than twenty-five children have perfect papers, then those with a perfect record will be assembled again, and given another fifty words.

7. If in grading the papers it is found that every child has missed one word, or more than one word out of the first fifty spelled, the children who have missed the fewest number will be taken together again and given a second list of fifty words until all but twenty-five have been eliminated.

8. A contestant may request that a word be repronounced or defined. The pronouncer shall grant the request until the officials agree that the word has been made sufficiently plain to the contestants.

9. Though some authorities prefer one spelling and some another of words spelled in more than one way, the rule of reason dictates that any form acceptable to standard authorities shall be judged correct.

10. No person will be allowed in the room during the testing period except the contestants, the judges, the pronouncers, and the committee.

11. Any question relating to the spelling of a word must be referred to the judges immediately.

12. Any protest must be made to the judges promptly. No protest can be entertained after the contest has been terminated.

13. The judges of the contest are in complete control of the contest from the moment the first word is pronounced. Their action must be final on all questions.

14. The names of the twenty-five successful contestants will be announced at the close of the preliminary contest in the morning. All teachers should save these rules for future reference, it is suggested by Mrs. Lucile Sharp Brown, chairman.

Rules For The Oral Contest Spelling Bee, March 21.

1. The spelling in the final contest shall be oral.

2. The spellers may pronounce words before or after spelling them or not at all.

3. Any speller failing to spell a word shall drop out of the contest, and another word shall be given the next in line. Having started to spell a word, a contestant shall be given an opportunity to change letters pronounced. A speller, having started to spell a word, may retrace, provided the letters and their sequence are not changed in their retracing.

4. When the contestants are reduced to two, the speller who first corrects a word misspelled by the other, and then spells the next word in the list, shall be declared the winner. If both misspell the same word, both shall continue in the contest. Should one err, and the other, after correcting the error, misspell the new word submitted to him then the misspelled word shall be referred to the first speller for correction, and if he succeeds in correcting the error, and in spelling the next word in the list, he shall be declared the champion.

5. The winner of the finals shall go to the state contest in Louisville in April, and will be given a cash prize, the amount of which will be announced later.

6. The words for the oral match will also be selected by someone out of the county. This list will be sealed in an envelope and opened in the presence of the contestants and visitors on the afternoon of the contest. The pronouncers will be required to follow the order of the words as they appear in the list. These words will also be taken from the same three spellers listed in the first announcement, except the last fifty will be made up of more difficult words, from another source.

7. Rules 1, 7, 8, 11, 12, 13, and 14 relating to the written contest apply also to the final oral contest.
