The plaintiff, A. B. Teater, states that the defendant, E. Price Hanna, is indebted to him in the sum of \$ 65.75 for goods wares and merchandise furnished and delivered to defendant by plaintiff at defendant's special instance and request during the year of 1923 and for which the defendant promised and agreed~~to~~ to pay for said goods.

He files herewith as a part hereof, marked " A " an account showing the character of goods and merchandise so furnished and delivered, the prices charged therefor and states that all of said prices are reasonable, and that there is now due and owing unto this plaintiff by the defendant the sum of \$ 65.75 and that altho often requested the defendant has failed and refused and still fails and refuses to pay all or any part of said account and same remains wholly unpaid.

Plaintiff says that defendant is entitled to a credit to the above amount not to exceed \$ 7.00.

Pleading further, plaintiff says that he is informed and believes that defendant is now employed by the L. E. Myers Company who have offices or an agent in Mercer County, Kentucky.

Plaintiff says that this is an action upon a contract, that the defendant has no property in this State subject to execution or not enough thereof to satisfy the plaintiff's demand, and that the collection of the demand will be endangered by delay in obtaining judgment or a return of no property found.

WHEREFORE, plaintiff, prays for judgment against the defendant
