

The Plaintiff says that it is a corporation under the laws of Kentucky entitled and authorized to sue and to be sued, to contract and be contracted with and to carry on the general business of banking; that on August 18th, 1924 the defendant executed and delivered to it his written promisory note by which ~~it~~ he agreed to pay it three months thereafter the sum of \$421.50 with interest from date until paid; that he has paid on said note different payments so that on Dec. 1, 1927 he had paid the interest thereon to that date and all of the principal except \$211.89; that on Dec. 6, 1927 he paid on the principal \$85.27 leaving due it thereon the sum of \$116.62 with interest from that date; that no part thereof has ever been paid to it; a copy of said note is filed herewith as a part hereof for identity.

Wherefore it prays judgment for \$116.62 with 6% interest from Dec. 1, 1927 until paid and costs and for all proper relief
