The plaintiff, Daniel Carey, says that Page Lewis has in his possession a mule belonging to him and said mule is described as follows: It is a black mare mule about 6 or 7 years of age and has a crooked hind ankle and is of the value of at least \$25.00. His cause of action accrued within the last year-

Wherefore, plaintiff prays for an order of delivery for said mule if said mule can be delivered and if not he prays for a judgment against the defendant in the sum of \$25.00 and that costs of this action and for \$10.00 damages for the wrongful detention and use of said mule. He prays for all relief-
