The plaintiff the Geo. Bohon Co. states that is is a corporation doing business under the Laws of the State of Kentucky with its principal place of business at Harrodsburg, Mercer County Kentucky. It states that on the 1st day of Feby. 1915, the defendant P.T. Williams executed and delivered to them a certain promissory note, by the terms of which on the 1st day of July 1915, after date, he promised to pay to the order of this plaintiff, the sum of \$110.28 with interest thereon from maturity until paid. He states that said note was executed for value received and that same is long since past due and no part of same has been paid. Said note is filed herewith as a part hereof marked "A" for identity. The plaintiff states that on the above mentioned dated, for the purpose of securing the above indebtedness, the defendant executed acknowledged and delivered to this plaintiff a certain mortgage whereby he conveyed to this plaintiff, one brown gelding, 6 years old, called "Prince"; one suckling shetland pony called "Teddy". It states that said mortgage was duly recorded in M.B. 36, page 106, of record in the office of the Clerk of the Mercer County Court. It states that by reason of said mortgage it has a valid and subsisting lien upon the above mentioned property to secure the above note interest and costs of this action. Said mortgage is filed herewith as apart hereof, marked "B" for Identity.
