The plaintiff, Central Wholesale Company, states that it is a corporation duly organized under the laws of the state of Kentucky.

It says at the special instance and request of the defendant it sold and delivered to him goods, wares and merchandise to the amount of \$301.08 for which he agreed and promised and pay the said amount, but no part thereof has ever been paid except the sum of \$152.60, leaving a balance due upon said account of \$148.48.

It says that monthly statements were rendered to the defendant and itemized account of said monthly statements so rendered are filed herewith.

Wherefore it prays judgment against the defendant for the said sum of \$148.48 with interest thereon and for its cost and for all proper relief.
