UPON PETITION

-----JUDGMENT-----

The Plaintiff, Zoletta G. Curry, Executrix of the will of George A. Curry having filed her verified petition, and upon all the proceedings herein and upon proof heard, it is made to appear to the Court that Zoletta G. Curry is justly and legally entitled in her own right to the following stocks and bonds:-

5 Shares stock in American Telephone & Telegraph Co, certificates N.E. #32965, no par value;
20 Shares stock in Louisville & Nashville Railroad Co \$100.00 par value certificates N.Y.C. #3105, 28897 and 18800;
31 Shares stock in American Alliance Insurance Co \$100.00 par value Certificates C #289, 260 and 304;
24 shares stock in Great American Insurance Co \$100.00 par value certificates E #1722 and 330, D #4116, 3298 xxxi 3249; and 2454;
34 Shares stock in The E. F. Goodrich Co, common no par value Certificates 182755
1 5% Bond Armour & Co of Delaware, D #4370 par value \$500.00.

The Court finds that each and all of said stock certificates are in the possession of the plaintiff Executrix and although some of them run in the name of G. A. Curry and some in the name of George A. Curry, that they are one and the same person and that all of said stocks and bonds are now the property of the plaintiff as Executrix of George A. Curry; and that under his will the whole thereof is devised absolutely to Zoletta G. Curry.

It is therefore ordered, adjudged and decreed that the said Zoletta G. Curry, as Executrix of the will of George A. Curry, be, and she is hereby, authorized to execute an assignment of said stocks and bonds to herself individually to the end that she may have new stocks and bonds issued in her name and her title thus perfected.
