The defendant A. L. Burrus having been duly summoned and failing to answer, it is adjudged that the plaintiff recover of him \$90.00 with 6% interest thereon from Aug. 27, 1921, and \$36.00 with 6% interest from March 29, 1921, and also its costs herein expended.

It appearing that the defendant J. M. Burrus has been duly summoned but has failed to answer, it is adjudged by the Court that the mortgage referred to in the ~~amended~~ petition dated Nov. 7, 1922 and on record in the Mercer County Court Clerk's Office was executed and given when A. L. Burrus was insolvent to secure an antecedent debt; that therefore said mortgage has in law the effect of an assignment of all the property of the said A. L. Burrus, to said J. M. Burrus for the benefit of the creditors of said A. L. Burrus; that said property and estate be administered as an assigned estate. This cause is continued until the next term of this Court, and a rule is awarded against J. M. Burrus requiring him to answer herein and disclose what property he received under said mortgage with the disposition thereof and requiring him to account for the same herein; the ~~to~~ ~~max~~ property described in said mortgage included all his 1922 tobacco crop, a bunch of sheep, a sheep separator and other personalty.
