Deft

The Plff, F C Randall states that the Deft, D.T. Bohon Company is a corporation duly organized under the laws of the State of Kentucky, and doing business in Harrodsburg, Ky, as a manufacturer and retailer of buggies and other vehicles.

He says that on the 26th day of May 1915, at the special instance and request of the Deft, D.T. Bohon Company, he sold and delivered to the said Company, one No. 2 Combination wheel bolter, for which the Defendant agreed and promised to pay the sum of \$150., which was the price of said wheel bolter, which was reasonable, and that the said shipment was received and accepted by the Defendant upon the terms and conditions that they were to pay for the same within 30 days, no part of which has ever been paid. They sayd that said account was due June 6th 1915, and bears interest from said date.

Wherefore he prays judgment against the Deft for the sum of \$150. with interest thereon from ~~xxx~~ June 6th, at the rate of 6 per cent per annum, and for their cost and all proper relief.
