Royal Kyler,

The Pliffs, Sanders & Norton & Co states that it is a

partnership organized for the purpose of trade and that it is composed
of the Pliffs, A Sanders, Joe Sanders and D W Norton. They say that
Deft Royal Kyler, by his promissory note, dated Aug 20th 1913, which he
executed and delivered to the Pliffs, agreed and promised 6 months
thereafter to pay to the Pliffs the sum of \$70., no part of which has
ever been paid except the sum of \$10. which was paid Dec 28th 1914.
They state that said note bears interest at the rate of 7
per cent per annum, and was given in consideration of 16 head of sheep
on which said note was a lien to secure the payment thereof; that the
said Kyler has fraudulently sold and disposed of the said sheep.

They state that the said Kyler, Deft hereto, is about to sell, convey
and otherwise dispose of his property with the intent to cheat, hinder
and delay his creditors, and that he is about to remove his property
or a material part thereof out of this State, not leaving enough
herein to satisfy the Pliffs claim and the claims of the Deft's
creditors. They state that the claim is just and that the Pliffs
ought to recover the said amount of \$70. with interest thereon from
date. They file said note herewith, and pray judgment against the
Deft for the said sum of \$70. with interest thereon from the 20th
of Aug 1913, subject to the credit of \$10. paid as aforesaid, and for
a general order of attachment against the property of the Deft.
