The plaintiffs, W. H. Royalty and W. P. Royalty, state that they are partners, doing business under the firm name of Royalty Bros., and are engaged in a general merchandising business at Salvisa, Mercer County, Kentucky.

The plaintiffs state that on the 1st day of January, 1921, the defendant, Charley Jones, by his certain promissory note of said date, by him executed and delivered to the plaintiffs, agreed and promised to pay the plaintiffs, Twelve Months thereafter, the sum of Fifty-four Dollars (\$54.00), with interest thereon from the date ~~of execution~~ until the same shall be paid. The said note is hereto attached and filed as a part hereof, ~~marked~~ "Exhibit A," for the purpose of identification.

The plaintiffs state that the said note is past due, and that no part thereof has been paid.

WHEREFORE, the plaintiffs pray judgment against the said defendant, Charley Jones, for the said sum of Fifty-four Dollars (\$54.) with interest thereon at the rate of six per cent. per annum from Janu-
