The Plaintiffs state that the defendant by his promissory note dated April 15, 1920 agreed and promised to pay them seven months thereafter the sum of \$162.92 with interest from date until paid; said note is past due and unpaid; it is filed as a part hereof marked Note for identity; that this is an action to recover money due on said note; that said sum is just due and owing and they believe they should recover said full sum; that the defendant has no property in this state subject to execution and ~~is~~ not enough thereof to satisfy this debt interest and costs, and the collection thereof will be endangered by delay in obtaining judgment and a return of no property found.
