The plaintiff D.H.Coleman, says that between the days of January, 1. 1924 & Jan. 1, 1925 he performed medical services for the defendant, at his special instance and request, to the value of \$68.00. Plaintiff says that no part of said sum has been paid nor any interest thereon; that plaintiff has requested defendant to pay the same at divers times and especially on January 1, 1925. He says that the defendant has failed and refused to pay said claim; that defendant has no property in this State, Subject to execution, or not enough thereof to pay plaintiff and his other creditors; that said claim will be endangered by delay in obtaining judgement and return of no property found; he says that the claim is just, due and unpaid and that he ought, as he believes, to recover thereon the sum of \$68.00.

Wherefore plaintiff prays judgement against the defendant in the sum of \$68.00 with interest at the rate of Six percent from Jan. 1, 1925 until paid, for a general order of attachment against the property of the defendant, for his costs and to all other relief to which he appear entitled.
