To The Hon. Judge of The Mercer County Court, W. H. Kennedy, Sher-

iff of Mercer County, and John C. Horn, Assessor for Mercer County;

The foregoing complainants say that the said Tom Squitler in the month of July, 1922, was the owner of a house and lot in Harrodsburg, Ky., located on Price Avenue, which he assessed for city, county, state and school taxes, the valuation thereof being fixed at \$1700.00; that on Sep. 29, 1922, he sold said house & lot to Garnett Knight, who on Nov. 8, 1922, sold the same to Ed. Sutherland, who in turn sold the same to Joe. Leonard in August, 1923. Complainants say that in each

deed from Squitler to Leonard, the Grantee agreed to pay the taxes assessed

against said property ⁱⁿ for the year 1922, and that Joe. Leonard, the last grantee,

is willing to pay the tax on assessment, but he finds from the records of the

Sheriff of Mercer County and assessor that said property is wrongfully

listed for taxation to to Garnett Knight and Ed. Sutherland; he, therefore, re-

fuses to pay the tax until a correction is made of the errors against Knight

and Sutherland. Now the errors occurred Complainants are not advised, but

the fact remains that the same property is assessed to THREE different persons

Squitler, Knight and Sutherland. This is clerical error which complainants

respectfully ask to be corrected under section 4250 of the Ky. Statutes.

The errors mentioned were discovered Sep. 5, 1923.
