The Plaintiff says that the defendant is indebted to him in the sum of \$158.11 as evidenced by note dated the 25 day of Jan 1913 filed herewith with interest from said date subject to the following credits;

that said sum is long past due and unpaid; that by the terms of said note he was given and now has a lien on the following furniture to secure the payment thereof; 1 range, 1 extension table, 6 chairs, 1 kitchen table 1 dresser 1 stand table, 1 brass bed 1 chair 1 sand table, 1 rocker 1 mattress

there are no other liens thereon and that he is entitled to recover possession of the said furniture for sale in satisfaction of his claim.

Wherefore he prays judgment for said sum less the credits for judgment of possession and for costs and all proper relief.
