The plaintiff, Elbinger Shoe Manufacturing Co., states that it is a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of Ohio and as such it is authorized to contract and be contracted with to sue and be sued.

Plaintiff states that Royalty & Royalty doing business under the firm name of Royalty Bros. is indebted to it in the sum of \$187.65 together with interest thereon at the rate of six percent per annum from August 26, 1920 for goods, wares and merchandise sold and delivered to defendants at their special instance and request by plaintiff for which defendants promised and agreed to pay the sum aforesaid of \$187.65 and that said goods, wares and merchandise were reasonably worth the sum which defendants promised and agreed to pay therefor but that defendants have failed, neglected and refused to pay the same though having often been demanded so to do. Plaintiff files herewith as a part hereof itemized statement of said account marked A.

Wherefore plaintiff prays for judgment against the defendants for the sum of \$187.65 and interest thereon at the rate of six percent per annum from August 26, 1920 and for its costs herein and for all proper relief.
