The Plaintiffs state that on Jan'y 17, 1921 the defendant L.C. Chambers by his promisory note of that date agreed to pay Elmo Royalty six months thereafter \$200 negotiable and payable at plff bank; that by the terms of said note presentment for payment protest and notice of protest was waived; that before maturity the said Elmo Royalty for value received negotiated transferred and delivered said note by his written endorsement on the back thereof to the plaintiff bank and it now owns and holds the same; said note is long past due and no part thereof has been paid except the interest to July 17, 1921.

Wherefore plaintiffs pray judgment against L. C. Chambers and Elmo Royalty for \$200 with 6% interest from July 17, 1921 until paid and costs and all proper relief.
