The Plaintiffs state that on Jany 17, 1921 the defendant L.C. Chambers by his promisory note of that date agreed to pay Elmo Royalty six months thereafter \$200 negotiable and payable at plff bank; that by the terms of said note presentment for payment protest and notice of protes was waived; that before maturity the said Elmo Royalty for value received n gotiated transferred and delivered said note by his written endorsement on the back thereof to the plaintiff bank and it now owns and holds the same; said note is long past due and no part thereof has been paid except the interest to July 17, 1921.
