

Warrant of Arrest

The Commonwealth of Kentucky,

To the Sheriff, Constable, Jailer, Marshal or Policeman in the State of Kentucky:

It appearing that there are reasonable grounds for believing that
Hugh Arnold, and D Gray,

has committed the offense of
illegally possessing intoxicating liquors and not for medical
purposes and D Gray for aiding and abetting said Arnold
for the possession of said liquor
in the County of Mercer, the 6th day of November-1932. 193

You are therefore commanded to arrest said Hugh Arnold and D Gray,

and bring them before me to be dealt with according to law.

November 1932.
