The affiant W D Sparrow states that the Deft Aleck Miller is indebted to him in the sum of \$24.50 for medical services rendered his family in the year 1915, at the special request of the Defendant; no part of which has been paid. He states that said sum is due upon contract with the Deft as above stated, and that the Deft has no property in this State subject to execution or not enough thereof to satisfy Plff's demand, and that the collection of the debt will be endangered by delay in obtaining judgment or return of no property found. He further states that that the Deft has sold, conveyed or otherwise disposed of his property and suffered and permitted it to be sold with the fraudulent intent to cheat, hinder and delay his creditors and especially this Plff. He asks that the Mercer Farmers Loose Leaf Tobacco Warehouse Co and Burley Tobacco Ware House Company, and J D Baxter, be summoned as garnishees herein. Affiant states that his claim is for money due on contract; that it is just and he believes he ought to recover of Deft \$24.50 and his cost herein expended.
