The plaintiff, H.S.Mathis, says that for the year 1922, he rented to the defendant, Mary E. Graves, 4 rooms on second floor of the James Building, in Harrodsburg, Ky- for the sum of \$20.00 per month; that she without his consent or permission took possession of a portion of hall on said floor and converted it into a room which she curtained off, furnished and used as a sleepin room for her guests and boarders and that said room was so used by her for the full period of 12 months and that a reasonable compensation for the use of said room as aforesaid is \$4.00 per month and that no part of said sum has ever been paid though repeatedly demanded- He further says that the rooms occupied by her were damaged by her in the sum of \$10.00- That under said contract she agreed and promised to pay all damage to said rooms-

Wherefore, plaintiff prays for a judgment against the defendant in the sum of \$58.00 and all the costs of this action- He prays for all relief to which he is or may appear to be entitled-
