Plaintiff, Mercer Garage & Welding Company, a partnership composed of Tom Durr, Curr Marksburry and A.W. Comingo, states that there is due to it the sum of \$63.23, said sum being for material furnished and work done upon defendant's car.

Plaintiff states that said work was done and said materials were furnished said defendant by said plaintiff at the special instance and request of the defendant for which he promised to pay the amount set out, itemized statement of said account is filed herewith as part hereof.

Plaintiff states that this is an action for money due on said account being a contract to pay money; they it believes it should have and recover the full value of said account together with interest and costs of this action; that the defendant has not sufficient property to satisfy and pay said indebtedness in this state nor has he sufficient property subject to execution to satisfy and pay the same and the collection thereof will be endangered by delay in obtaining judgment and return of no property found.

Wherefore, plaintiff prays judgment for \$63.23 with interest six per cent from date of maturity of account for costs of this suit and for a general order of attachment of defendant's property and prays generally for all judgments and orders and reliefs to which it may appear to be entitled.
