The Plaintiff, John Y. Divine, states that the Defendants, L.H.DeBell, E.D.DeBell and C.B.DeBell, by their promissory note dated Sep. 15, 1919, which they executed and delivered to Plaintiff, promised and agreed to pay him ten months thereafter the sum of One Hundred & Thirty Dollars (\$130.00), with interest thereon from maturity, at the rate of 6 per centum per annum until paid. No part of said note or interest has been paid. It is filed herewith as part hereof marked "B". Said note was due July 15, 1920.

Wherefore Plaintiff prays judgment against the Defendants for the sum of One Hundred and Thirty Dollars (\$130.00) and interest at the rate of six per cent per annum from July 15, 1920 until paid, and his cost herein expended. He prays for all proper relief.
