Plaintiffs, Henry Adams and Will Langford state that under date of April 1st., 1921 they were partners in the milling business with their principal place of business in Harrodsburg, Mercer County, Kentucky and operating said business under the firm name of Adams & Langford.

They state that the defendant, F.C. Chelf by a writing dated April 1st., 1921 which he executed and delivered to plaintiffs and which is filed herewith as part hereof marked "Exhibit A" promised to pay to plaintiffs the sum of \$128.00 after said date, to wit, on the first day of August 1921, with interest six per cent from date until paid.

Plaintiffs state that the Defendant has not paid said note and that no part of the interest has been paid thereon since the first day of January 1922 at which time and date defendant paid the interest on said note leaving at this time the interest on same from date of January 1, 1922.
