The affiant F P James states that he is President of the First National Bank of Harrodsburg; that the defendant J W Cannon is indebted to the said Bank in the sum of \$20.00, evidenced by his promissory note dated Oct 31st 1924, which he executed and delivered to the plaintiff and by which he agreed and promised one month thereafter to pay to the plaintiff the said sum of \$20. with interest thereon from date, no part of which has ever been paid. That he is further indebted to the plaintiff in the sum of \$1.89 which sum the defendant owes by reason of the plaintiff having paid a check drawn by the defendant on the plaintiff and which the plaintiff paid, for the sum of \$1.89 in excess of the amount then deposited by the defendant in the plaintiff's bank. That the said amount of \$21.89 is just and that the plaintiff ought to recover said sum; that the defendant has no property in this State subject to execution and that the collection of plaintiff's demand will be endangered by delay in obtaining judgment and a return of no property found.
