


has been repeatedly demanded; that he ought to recover thereon said
sum- That the defendant has no property in this State subject to ex-
ecution or not enough thereof to satisfy plaintiff's demand and that
the collection of said demand will be endangered by delay in obtain-
ing a judgment and a return of no property found to satisfy same-

Wherefore plaintiff prays for a judgment against the defendant
in the sum of \$18.83 and interest from the 21st day of February,
1916, until paid and for the further sum of \$2.50 for flour and all the
costs of this action and for all the relief to which he is or may ap-
pear to be entitled including a general order of attachment against the
property of the defendant and a summons against the Burley Tobacco Growers
Cooperative Association as garnishee- He prays for all relief-
