Plaintiff says that this is an action for money due upon a contract; that it is just, due and unpaid though payment has been repeatedly demanded; that he ought to recover thereon said sum- That the defendant has no property in this State subject to execution or not enough thereof to satisfy plaintiff's demand and that the collection of said demand will be endangered by delay in obtaining a judgment and a return of no property found to satisfy same-

Wherefore plaintiff prays for a judgment against the defendant in the sum of \$18.83 and interest from the 21st day of February, 1916, until paid and for the further sum of \$2.50 for flour and all the costs of this action and for all the relief to which he is or may appear to be entitled including a general order of attachment against the property of the defendant and a summons against the Burley Tobacco Growers Cooperative Association as garnishee- He prays for all relief-
