The Plaintiff Harrodsburg Implement Company, states that ~~ixxis~~ on Aug 12th 1924 the defendant Delbert Divine by his promissory note which he executed and delivered to the plaintiff, agreed and promised on the 1st day of Jany 1925, to pay to the plaintiff \$\$\$\$\$ \$200.00 with interest thereon from date ; that to secure the payment of said note the defendant mortgaged to the plaintiff one Ford touring car 1923 model, and also one-third interest in 12 acres of tobacco then growing on the George Divine farm in Mercer County, Ky, three miles from Harrodsburg on the Handy pike, and also one-half interest in one-third of 30 acres of corn then growing and raised upon the said George Divine farm.

It says that the plaintiff's claim is just and that it ~~might~~ ought to recover of the defendant the said amount \$200. with interest aforesaid and its cost herein expended.

That the defendant has ~~departed~~ left the county of his residence to avoid the service of a summons or so conceals himself that a summons cannot be served upon him ; that he has removed a portion of his property including the automobile on which the plaintiff has a mortgage, out of this State, that he has sold, conveyed or otherwise disposed of his property or suffered or permitted it to be sold with the fraudulent intent to cheat hinder and delay his creditors.

Wherefore the plaintiff prays for a general order of attachment against the defendant's property and that the interest of the defendant in the said tobacco crop and the said corn crop be subject to the payment of the plaintiff's debt and that a general order
