vs Amended Petition


Herbert Divine and Joe Divine,

The Plaintiff by leave of Court amends his petition herein and says that the contract of rental for the George Divine farm was made between the First National Bank Committee for George Divine, and Joe Divine, who is the father of the defendant, Delbert Divine: that the said Joe Divine thereupon placed the said Delbert Divine and another brother on said farm to cultivate the same under a contract and agreement: that the said Delbert Divine was to have a one-third interest in 12 acres of tobacco then growing upon the said farm and which was cultivated by the said Delbert Divine in connection with his brother, and also one-half of one-third of thirty acres of corn.

It says that the said Joe Divine is now in the possession of the interest of the said Delbert Divine in said tobacco and is appropriating and converting the same to his own use and that he is in the possession of the tobacco including the interest of said Delbert Divine.

Wherefore it prays that the said George Divine be compelled to pay into Court the interest of the said Delbert Divine in said tobacco and said corn, and to account to plaintiff for all sums received therefrom. It prays for all general and equitable relief.
