**Army Offers Fast Message Service**

**Mother To Wire Freed Son**

The first word from Mrs. Carrie Quinn to her newly-freed son, Sgt. Charles R. Quinn, Jap prisoner of war rescued by Filipino guerillas and American Rangers, will go at the expense of the government.

When The Journal informed Mrs. Quinn last night of the government's offer, she said, "I'll send him word in the morning and in the quickest way.

"I don't know how I'll get everything I have to say into 25 words, but I'll try," she added.

According to a United Press dispatch last night, immediate families of the Americans liberated from the Jap prison camp on Luzon may send them a 25-word telegram. The Army will transmit the message from Washington without cost to the sender.

Messages must be addressed in care of the Adjutant General's office, Washington, D. C., for forwarding to Luzon. They either may be mailed or telegraphed and should specify the relationship of the liberated man to the sender and

include his rank and serial number. It would be helpful, an Army official said, if the sender noted that the addressee was one of the men rescued from the Japs.

The freed men are expected to be removed from Luzon as quickly as possible, so unless families act immediately mail may take some time to catch up with the men. It was not disclosed whether the liberated men will be able to send similar telegrams to their families.

Men well enough will be returned to the United States as quickly as possible, while those requiring hospitalization probably will be sent to New Zealand or Australia before they undertake the trip home.
