The Plaintiff, J. B. Scanlon, states that the defendant is a corporation under the laws of some State unknown to it but that it is engaged in business in Mercer County Kentucky where it maintains an office; that on the day of February 1921 in Harrodsburg, Mercer County Ky, the defendant, through its servant operated, managed and controlled its truck in such a reckless and careless manner as that he ran said truck into, and against the plaintiff's horse and wagon causing the horse to take fright and run and to totally destroy the wagon, the harness on said horse and to so badly injure said horse as to render him worthless; that he has been damaged for the horse \$45.00 for the harness \$10 and for the wagon \$20, a total sum of \$75.00.

Wherefore he prays judgment against the defendant for \$75 and costs and for all proper relief.
