Trip To Dayton Out For Quinn

Sgt. Charles Quinn, one of 513 Yankees freed from the Japanese prison camp, Cabanatuan, in the Philippines and recently returned to San Francisco, is not likely to get back to Dayton during his current leave, his mother, Mrs. Carrie Quinn, 311 Morton avenue, said today.


Mrs. Quinn said she had talked with her son from Harrodsburg, Ky., this morning and that he had asked her to come there to see him because it is doubtful if he will be able to get to Dayton on his 10-day furlough. Mrs. Quinn left immediately.

Sergeant Quinn had gone to Harrodsburg first to tell his aunt the news of the death of her son at the hands of Japanese captors on the Philippines.
